Executive Summary

In response to the 2005 Rebuild America Program Area of the State Technologies Advancement Collaborative solicitation, the North Carolina Solar Center at North Carolina State University, in partnership with Washington State University, the Texas State Energy Conservation Office, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, and the North American Insulation Manufacturers Association (NAIMA), created a comprehensive, online database of energy efficiency policies and incentives implemented at the federal, state, local, and utility levels. The primary objective of the *National Database of Energy Efficiency Policies & Incentives* project was to provide an accurate, up-to-date technical assistance tool to support Rebuild America partnerships and related stakeholders nationwide in their efforts to (1) help building owners overcome financial barriers of implementing energy efficiency/green building projects and practices; and (2) develop effective rules, regulations, and other policies to encourage energy efficiency projects and green building practices.

The database was developed as an expansion of the NC Solar Center's online Database of State Incentives for Renewable Energy (DSIRE) project, which provides detailed information about state, local, federal, and utility financial incentives and regulatory policies that promote the use of renewable energy technologies. DSIRE has proven to be a critical resource for a wide audience, from consumers and businesses who need timely information on incentives in order to make purchasing decisions to government officials that have approval or influence over the creation of incentives and regulations. The project has become nationally and internationally recognized for its valuable work in the advancement of incentives and policies to support renewable energy and is now playing a similar role to improve energy efficiency in buildings. The NC Solar Center, with assistance from project team members, developed and maintained the accuracy of the expanded "DSIRE+EE" tool by conducting literature searches, communicating with its extensive network of state, local, and utility contacts throughout the country, reviewing agency and utility websites, and attending relevant conferences.

This project was implemented over a three-year period, from December 1, 2005 through January 30, 2009. The DSIRE+EE database was completed and available online by the end of Year 1, and a summary report was written to provide an overview of the research findings. Program information was updated in subsequent years, and new programs were continually added throughout the project period as they were implemented. During the life of the project our partners in Washington, Pennsylvania and Texas supported the project with a total of \$63,985.20 of cost share in the form of in-kind services. NAIMA also supported the project with direct cash contributions totaling \$30,000; and the North Carolina Solar Center provided \$20,000 of cost share in the form of in-kind services. These contributions brought the total cost share for the project to \$113, 985.20, over \$5,000 more than we had originally expected.

During the course of the 3 year project, a total of 1,228 policies and incentives for energy efficiency were added to DSIRE. Additionally, some of DSIRE's popular features were expanded to include information about these energy efficiency programs. DSIRE also used a variety of means to promote the new energy efficiency information. The DSIRE website has also experienced a significant increase in the amount of users since adding energy efficiency.

The North Carolina Solar Center included a task under our new comprehensive DSIRE contract with the National Renewable Energy Laboratory, effective June 2009, to continue updating our energy efficiency program information, and to add a new energy efficiency policy type to the database, Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standards. Additionally, the current DSIRE contract has been modified to provide funding to maintain our energy efficiency information in the time between the end of the STAC contract and the start of the new DSIRE contract. In short, the project will continue.

Project Results

The following is a qualitative and quantitative summary of the results of the four tasks related to the National Database of Energy Efficiency Policies & Incentives project.

Task 1: Add Energy Efficiency Incentive & Policy Modules to DSIRE.

A complete list of every policy and incentive added to DSIRE during the three-year contract period can be found in Appendix A of this report. Below is a break down of the different types of policies and incentives added to DSIRE during the contract period.

Activity A – Research and incorporate state government policies into DSIRE

During the three-year contract period, NC Solar Center staff, with help from the project partners, researched and created new summaries for a total of 115 of the follow state level regulatory policies for energy efficiency:

- Building Energy Codes (53 entries)
- Energy Standards for Public Buildings (49 entries)
- Appliance Standards (13 entries)

NC Solar Center staff also created new summaries for a total of 164 of the following state level financial incentives for energy efficiency:

- Personal and corporate tax credits and deductions (23 entries)
- Industry (manufacturing) recruitment (5 entries)
- Property tax abatements and exemptions (5 entries)
- Sales tax exemptions (11 entries)
- State bond programs (2 entries)
- State grant programs (24 entries)
- State loan programs (45 entries)
- State rebate programs (40 entries)

Activity B – Research and incorporate utility efficiency incentives into DSIRE (4th Q 2006).

During the three-year contract period, NC Solar Center staff, with help from the project partners, researched and created new summaries for a total of 824 utility incentives for energy efficiency. Like all entries in DSIRE these are updated at least annually or as program changes require.

Activity C – Research and incorporate federal incentives & policies into DSIRE (2nd Q 2006).

During the three-year contract period, NC Solar Center staff, with help from the project partners, researched and created new summaries for a total of 15 federal incentives and regulatory policies for energy efficiency.

Activity D – Research and incorporate local incentives & policies into DSIRE (2nd Q 2007).

During the three-year contract period, NC Solar Center staff, with help from the project partners, researched and created new summaries for a total of 66 of the following local policies and incentive for energy efficiency:

- Building energy codes (11 entries)
- Energy standards for public buildings (22 entries)
- Green building incentives (16 entries)
- Local grant programs (6 entries)
- Local loan programs (8 entries)
- Local rebate programs (3 entries)

Task 2: Enhance DSIRE Website to Incorporate Energy Efficiency Elements.

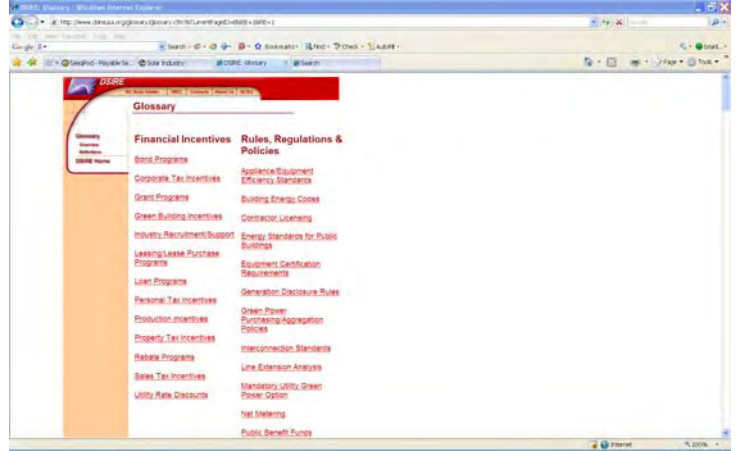


Figure 2: DSIRE FAQ Section

In addition to the inclusion of new program summaries, various improvements were made to the other useful DSIRE features to incorporate our new energy efficiency research. The [glossary](#) (Figure 1) was expanded during the 1st quarter of 2008 to include definitions for the energy efficiency policies and incentives tracked by DSIRE. The [FAQs](#) (Figure 2) section of DSIRE was also expanded to include our new energy efficiency information. The interactive [summary table](#) (Figure 3) of financial incentives for energy efficiency was enhanced during the 3rd quarter, 2006 to show utility and federal incentives in addition to state incentives. The [summary table](#) (Figure 4) of energy efficiency regulations and policies, as well as printable versions of both summary tables, were added to DSIRE during the 4th quarter of 2006. DSIRE was further enhanced during the 3rd quarter of 2007 to make the printable versions of both summary tables update automatically in real-time.

Task 3: Update and Enhance All Energy Efficiency Policies & Incentives Modules

Every record in DSIRE is updated at least annually, or as program changes merit. DSIRE has a variety of sources for maintaining our awareness of program changes, including national and regional newsletters, contacts at State Energy Offices and advocacy groups, our program partners, and even the users of DSIRE who will occasionally send us emails if they discover a program change before we do. If all else fails, we review all of our records annually and ask the program administrator to review it as well.

Task 4: Develop and Disseminate Project Information

A one-page flyer (Appendix B) was developed during the 4th quarter of 2006. The flyer was distributed at numerous conferences including:

- The Interstate Renewable Energy Council and Solar America Initiative Annual Meeting on October 16, 2006 in San Jose, California.
- The Solar Electric Power Association Conference on October 16 – 19, 2006 in San Jose, California
- The Annual Meeting of the National Association of State Energy Officials on February 11 – 13, 2007 in Washington, DC
- The American Solar Energy Society Conference on July 7 – 11, 2007 in Cleveland, OH

The flyer was also emailed to officials from every state energy office during the 4th quarter of 2006. The flyer was subsequently updated and distributed at other national conferences.

After the first year of the project, Brian Lips wrote a summary report of the key findings from the first year of research. The report included a variety of charts and graphs summarizing the types of incentives found and the most common types of energy efficient equipment being incentivized. The report was shared with the project partners and was available for state energy officials during the 2007 annual meeting of the National Association of State Energy Officials in Washington, DC.

DSIRE staff routinely speak at national conferences about the DSIRE website, and the addition of the energy efficiency modules are always mentioned. Notably, Brian Lips gave a presentation in Atlanta for the annual meeting of the Association of Energy Engineers during the 3rd quarter of 2007. The talk primarily focused on incentives and policies for solar energy, but a considerable amount of time was spent promoting all aspects of the DSIRE website and informing the audience about the addition of energy efficiency policies and incentives to the database.

Brian Lips also co-authored an online article¹ for the November-December 2008 edition of the US DOE State Energy Program's bimonthly newsletter, *Conservation Update*. The article was about policy trends in energy standards for public buildings and included a link to DSIRE. Brian Lips presented his findings through a US DOE Technical Assistance Project webinar² on December 17, 2008 to audience of more than 150 listeners.

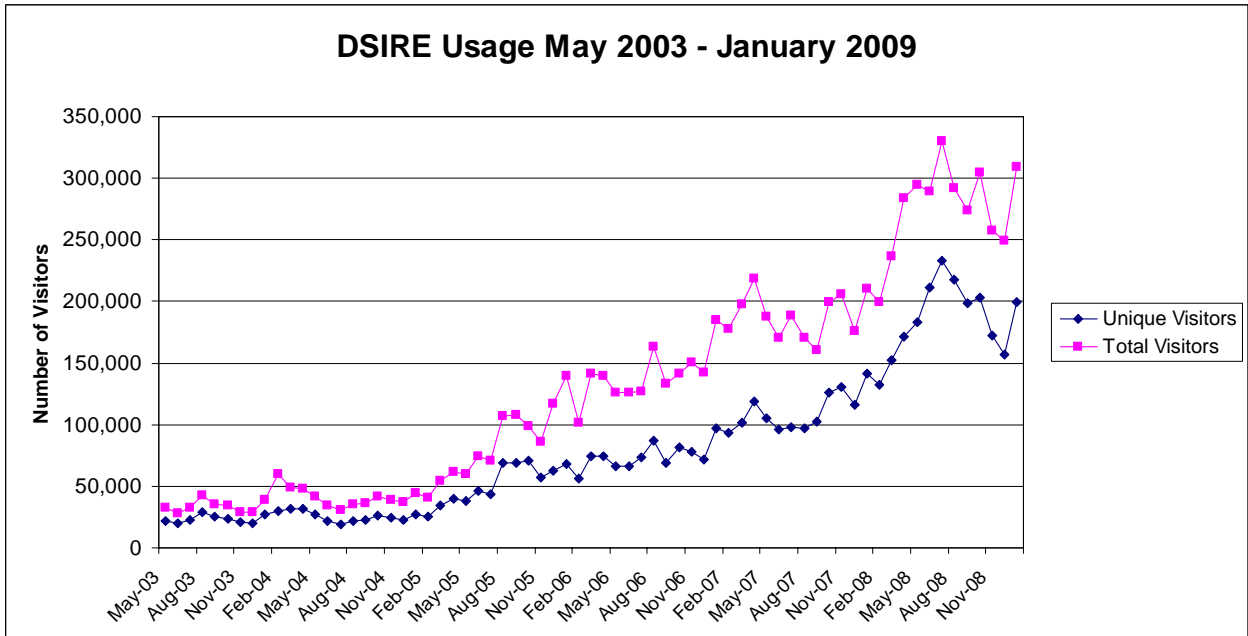
Lips also demonstrated how to use DSIRE before the Triangle Chapter of the US Green Building Council, and taught a 3 hour class during the NC Solar Center's Green Building Diploma Series about state policies and incentives that support green building practices.

Figure 5 shows the number of monthly visitors to the DSIRE website since we began tracking this information in May of 2003. You can see that DSIRE’s audience has continually increased during this period, with a marked increase coinciding with the addition of the energy efficiency modules.

INTRODUCTION

Over the past 10 years, the Database of State Incentives for Renewable Energy³ (DSIRE) has become the nation's most comprehensive source of information on state, local, utility and federal incentives and policies that promote the use of renewable energy. In 2006, DSIRE was expanded to include information on financial and regulatory programs that encourage or require energy efficiency upgrades, purchases of energy-efficient products, or construction of energy-efficient buildings. It's part of a 3-year project funded by the U.S. Department of Energy through the State Technologies Advancement Collaborative. Project partners include the North Carolina Solar Center at NC State University, Washington State University Extension Energy Program, the Texas State Energy Conservation Office, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, and the North American Insulation Manufacturers Association.

To reflect its expanded scope, the database has recently been renamed as the *Database of State Incentives for Renewables & Efficiency*. The familiar acronym remains the same – *DSIRE*.

The primary objective of the energy efficiency database is to provide a single source of information on all available incentives and policies that promote increased efficiency in the building sector, with a focus on schools, universities & colleges, state & local government buildings, commercial buildings, multi-family residential, and public housing. The project is designed to serve as a technical assistance tool to support Rebuild America partnerships and related stakeholders nationwide in their efforts to (1) help building owners overcome financial barriers associated with energy efficiency/green building projects and practices; and (2) develop effective rules, regulations, and other policies to encourage energy efficiency projects and green building practices.

This report summarizes the findings of the first year's research on over 900 state, federal and utility incentives and policies, providing an overview of the programs identified in the following categories:

Tax Incentives

State governments provide a variety of tax incentives to encourage energy efficiency, including tax credits or deductions, sales tax exemptions, and property tax exemptions or abatements . Tax credits directly reduce the amount of income tax owed by a taxpayer who implements eligible efficiency measures. Six states--Maryland, Massachusetts, Montana, New York, Oklahoma and Oregon--as well as the District of Columbia, offer personal tax credits for the adoption of energy-efficient technologies. Owners of single-family homes in Massachusetts, for example, can receive a credit worth 30% of the cost of efficiency improvements to their homes up to a maximum of \$600. Maryland, Massachusetts, New York and Oregon also offer corporate tax credits in addition to their personal tax credits. The corporate tax credits for Maryland and New York apply to the construction or renovation of buildings which meet the standards set forth by the U.S. Green Building Council or other similar criteria. Massachusetts and Oregon provide tax credits for the purchase of qualified energy-efficient equipment. In some cases, if a tax payer's annual tax burden is smaller than their tax credit, a state may allow unused credit to be carried over to future years.

Another tax incentive used by state governments is a tax deduction, which reduces taxable income by all or a percentage of an efficiency project's cost. DSIRE staff identified three states with tax deductions for energy efficiency; Arizona, California and Idaho. California's tax deduction allows its residents to write off the interest from their outstanding loans on energy-efficient purchases, while Idaho's program allows its residents to write off 100% of the material and labor costs associated with installing new insulation. Montana is the only state which offers a corporate tax deduction, which allows corporate taxpayers to deduct from their gross corporate income any capital investments they make in a building for energy conservation purposes.

Some state governments also encourage energy efficiency through a partial abatement or complete exemption of property taxes associated with efficiency improvements. Currently, only Nevada and New York offer property tax incentives for energy efficiency, and Maryland provides a local option. Maryland's local option allows counties and municipalities the option to provide a credit against the property tax for efficient buildings. New York's property tax exemption applies to improvements made to a home's weatherization and heating equipment, while Nevada offers a partial property tax abatement for commercial and industrial facilities which achieve a silver rating according to the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED standards.

And finally, some states endorse energy-efficient products by eliminating the sales tax associated with their purchase. Four states have experimented with this incentive, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia and Nevada. This is arguably the easiest incentive for consumers to participate in, as it is directly available at the time of purchase. The states which have incorporated this incentive have only made it available for selected time periods ranging from a few days to a few months. The DSIRE staff tracks these incentives throughout the year and makes them available to the public eye only during the time leading up to and during the promotional dates. Figure 1, below, shows the states currently offering the various types of tax incentives described above.

Low-Interest Loans

DSIRE staff documented 44 loan programs offered in 29 states. Half of these loans can be awarded to the public sector. Most residential loans are typically capped at \$10,000 to \$20,000, but most public institutions can borrow between \$100,000 and \$1,000,000, and sometimes there is no limit at all. The interest rates are kept low, sometimes tied to the prime rate and rarely exceeding 5%.

States have developed a variety of ways to fund their loan programs. Texas, South Carolina, Ohio, Missouri, Connecticut, Minnesota, Oklahoma, Nebraska, and Iowa maintain their funding through the use of revolving loans. States adopting revolving loans create an initial pool of money sometimes through direct appropriations, but usually by drawing money from either the petroleum violation (“oil overcharge”) escrow funds, or a public benefits fund. Under revolving loans, payments for outstanding loans are returned to the pool of money, which in turn can be used again to fund new loans. Revolving loans can then continue indefinitely, growing and expanding in scope over time depending on the interest rate charged.

Rebates

Rebates or buy-downs provide direct cash incentives for purchasing energy-efficient products, or achieving efficient building design. The DSIRE staff has reported on 29 rebate programs in 10 states and the District of Columbia. Since they require annual appropriations, they are primarily used by states with public benefits funds. Eleven of these rebate programs are available to residential customers. Residential rebates are typically prescriptive in nature, meaning a set amount of money is offered for different pieces of ENERGY STAR rated equipment, or homes which achieve an acceptable score on the Home Energy Rating System (HERS) or similar criteria. Equipment rebates typically range between \$50 and \$500, depending on the appliance.

Commercial and Industrial rebates, on the other hand, are more variable in nature. The rebate amount is often tied to the efficiency of the machinery, the size of the equipment, or to the total amount of energy saved by installing new equipment, retro-fitting old equipment or improving the efficiency of a process unique to the business.

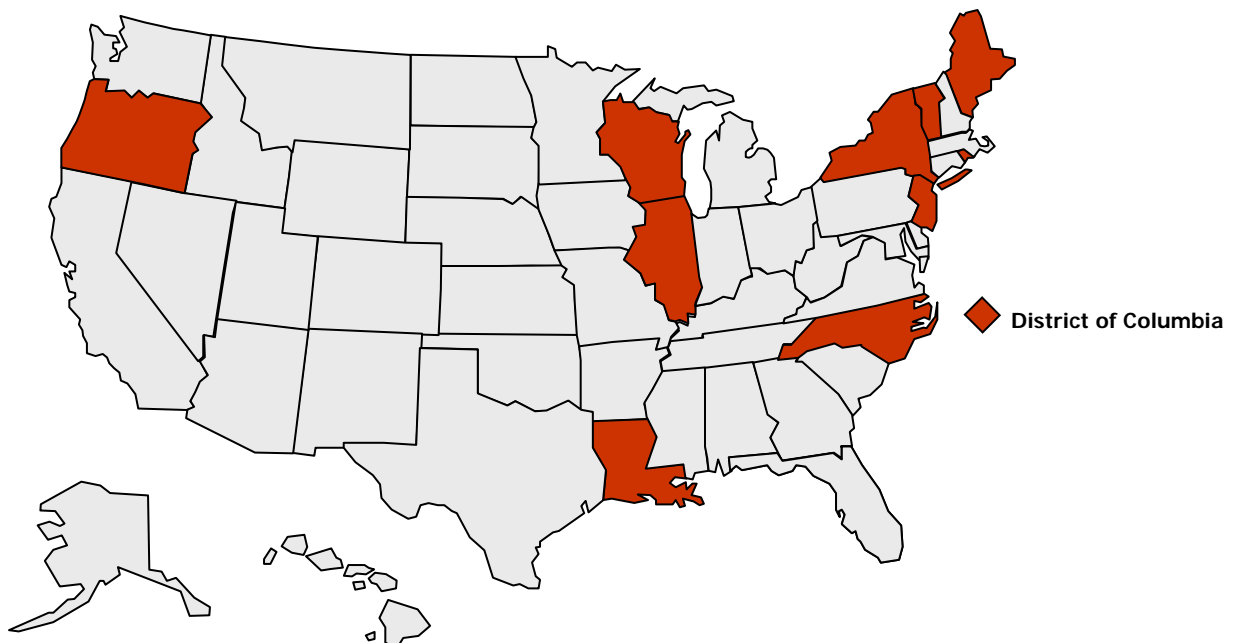


Figure 3: States with Rebate Programs for Energy Efficiency

Grant Programs

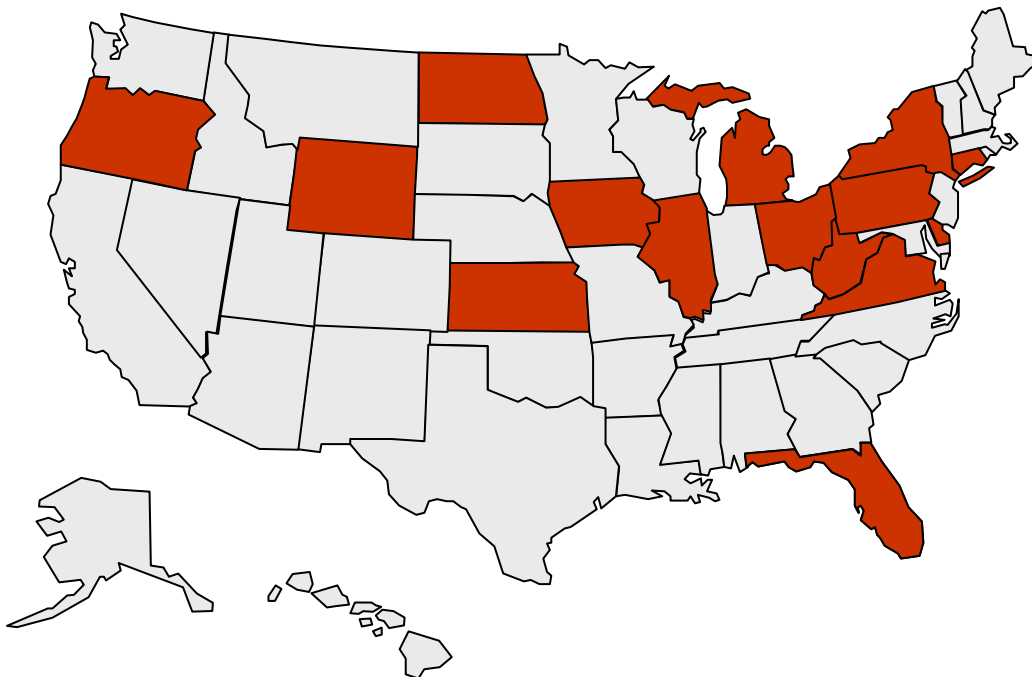


Figure 4: States with Grant Programs for Energy Efficiency

Grants are another incentive type states can utilize to encourage energy efficiency. States may use grants instead of loans if they are trying to promote emerging technologies which are not yet commercially viable or established in the marketplace, creating a barrier to the deployment of energy efficiency opportunities. The Pennsylvania Energy Development Authority, for example, provided \$5 million in 2006 to support research and development projects involving renewable energy, energy efficiency and load management. Grants may also be used in place of rebates in situations where the target consumer does not have the money required up-front to fund an efficiency purchase. Several state grant programs, including EmPower New York, will pay for a variety of weatherization measures for low-income residents with no contribution requirement. However, the majority of the 24 state-run grant programs identified by the DSIRE staff across 15 states, can be utilized by the public sector. West Virginia, for example, provides grants to schools, government facilities and hospitals to pay for 50% of the cost of lighting upgrades. Figure 4 highlights the states currently offering grants for energy efficiency.

Appliance and Equipment Efficiency Standards

The U.S. DOE develops labeling, test procedures and minimum efficiency standards for selected residential appliances and commercial equipment. These regulations apply to products manufactured for sale in the United States as well as imported products. While the minimum energy efficiency standards require manufacturers to discontinue manufacturing products that do not meet the efficiency standards, products manufactured before the effective date of the new standards may still be sold. New performance standards do not make equipment that is already installed obsolete. There is no requirement for consumers to replace existing equipment before the time that they would normally replace those appliances or pieces of equipment.

In addition to efforts by the federal government, eleven states have established minimum energy efficiency standards for many major commercial and residential appliances and other energy-consuming products. Arizona, California, Connecticut, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island and Washington have recently adopted appliance standards for additional products (typically ranging between four and six) beyond those covered under federal statutes. Some of the more common pieces of equipment these states have chosen to regulate include unit heaters, transformers, metal halide lamp fixtures and automatic commercial icemakers. California, the first state to adopt appliance efficiency standards, is currently seeking to develop its own water efficiency standard for residential clothes washers, and plans to petition DOE for an exemption. California has also enacted standards legislation that would go into effect if the federal standard is repealed or deemed invalid. Additionally, appliance manufacturers must file a statement for each appliance sold in California that is covered by federal or state law.

Building Energy Codes

An easy and cost-effective way to ensure that energy conservation is factored into regular building practices is to adopt mandatory building energy codes. The International Energy Conservation Code (IECC), developed and published by the International Code Council (ICC), is the most widely used set of criteria for efficient building practices. In the United States, building energy codes are adopted at the state level. Individual states are free to assess their own energy issues and adopt their own building energy codes in light of their climatic and economic conditions. Many states use IECC as their standard, either adopting its exact specifications, or adapting it to account for state-specific conditions. DSIRE staff coordinated with the Building Code Assistance Project (BCAP) to record building energy codes for all 50 states as well as the District of Columbia and Guam.

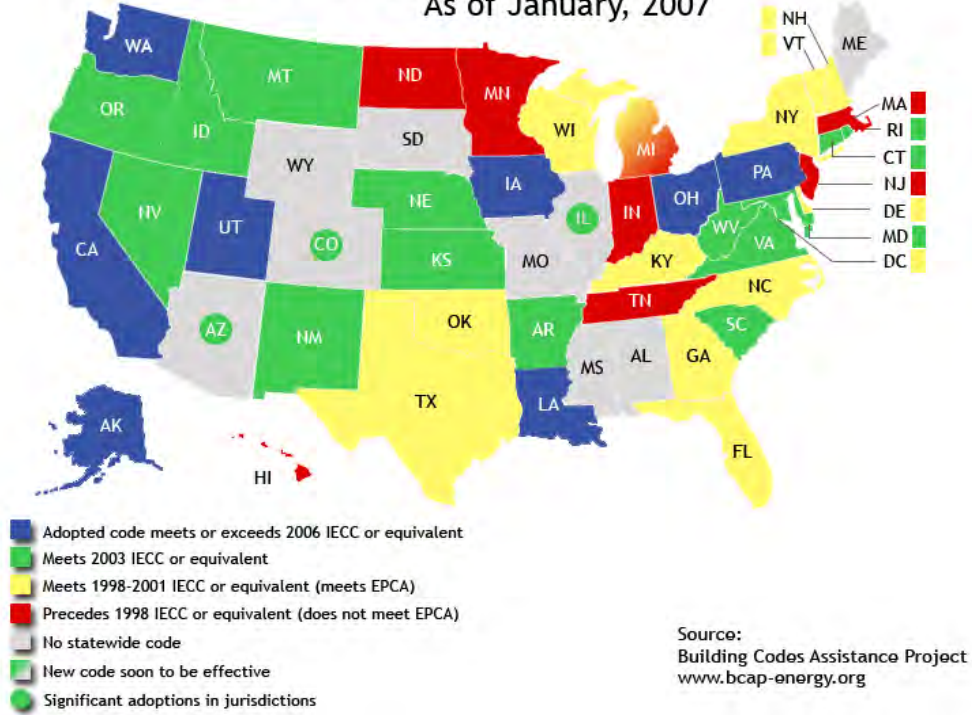


Figure 5: Status of Residential Energy Codes

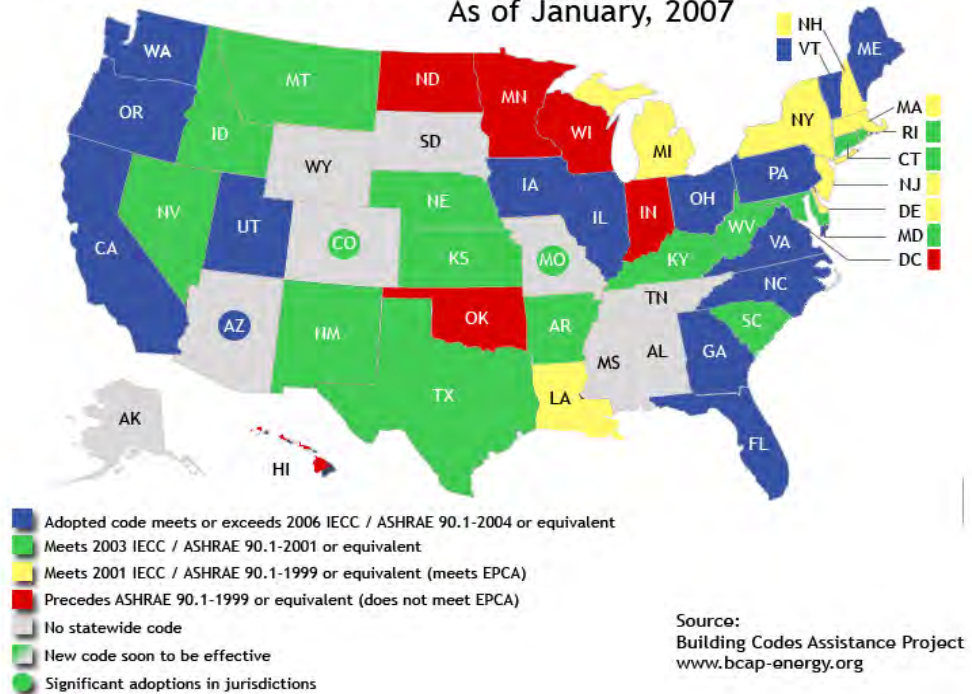


Figure 6: Status of Commercial Energy Codes

Presently, only two states, South Dakota and Missouri, have opted not to enforce a building energy code for commercial and residential buildings. Additionally, Illinois does not have an energy code for residential construction, and Alaska has no code for commercial construction. These states leave open the possibility of local jurisdictions adopting their own energy codes, but do not make requirements for them to do so. Three states, Alabama, Arizona and Hawaii have building energy codes for residential buildings which are not mandatory, but voluntary. Fourteen states have developed their own energy codes for residential buildings and 10 states have adopted their own codes for commercial construction. Some of the state-developed codes are more stringent than pre-established codes, and some are less stringent. Most states, however, have elected to adopt common, existing building energy codes. Of these states, 24 have adopted either 2003 IECC or a more stringent code. Figures 5 and 6 below, courtesy of the Building Energy Code Assistance Project (<http://www.bcap-energy.org>), show the status of state energy codes for the residential and commercial sectors respectively.

As of January, 2007

Energy Standards for Public Buildings

Another way state governments can encourage energy efficiency is to adopt energy standards for public buildings. Many state buildings are highly visible to the general public and can serve as good examples of successful conservation projects. Moreover, increasing the energy efficiency of state buildings can result in real dollar savings for the state, and help with national conservation efforts. DSIRE staff identified 37 initiatives across 24 states which have imposed some form of energy standard for public buildings.

Energy standards for public buildings can take several shapes depending on the goals and the needs of the state. Ten states, inspired by the Environmental Protection Agency’s ENERGY STAR Challenge, have established plans to reduce the consumption of electricity in public buildings by a certain percent over a given period of time. California, for example, plans to reduce electric consumption in their public buildings by 20% of 2003 levels by 2015. These are, in most cases, targets which are not mandated, only recommended. But state governments have created other mechanisms to help them reach these goals. Eleven states require state agencies to at least consider designing buildings which meet the requirements for LEED certification, or those of some comparable rating system. To that end, some states require that, when conducting life-cycle cost analysis for the construction of a new building or the renovation of an old building, state agencies must analyze energy-efficient products and incorporate them into the design if the analysis shows cost savings over a given period of time.

Some states, including New Jersey and Florida, have made requirements specifically for schools which can greatly benefit the state given the number of schools throughout a state, their size, and the potential educational benefits to their students. Florida, for example, requires all new schools to incorporate passive solar design, while New Jersey requires schools to score at least 26 points on the LEED rating scale.

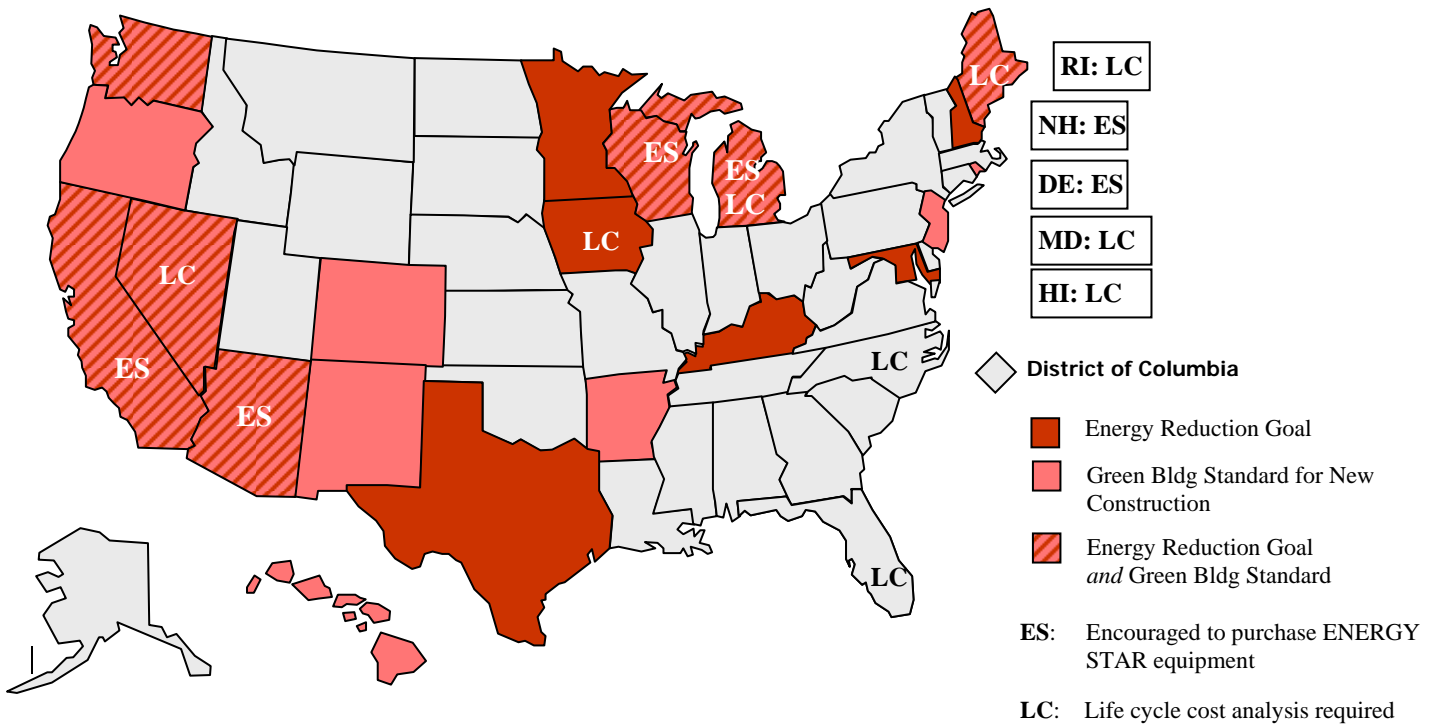


Figure 7: Energy Standards for Public Buildings

Public Benefits Funds for Energy Efficiency

With the restructuring of the electric utility industry in the 1990's, competition gave way to an evaporation of funds which had previously been supplied by utilities to promote energy efficiency. Given the utilities' reluctance to continue funding these programs and excess state appropriations for such programs unavailable, states started looking for new ways to fund energy efficiency. A new funding mechanism came into being which has proven highly effective in both financial stability and actual energy savings, public benefit funds (PBF's). The capital available within PBF's originates from a small per kilowatt-hour surcharge on customers' electric bills, typically ranging between 0.1 mill and 2 mills (a mill is equal to one tenth of one cent). The impact of this charge on a typical family is negligible, perhaps a dollar or two per month. But when pooled together across the state, these funds can have a very real impact on energy conservation efforts.

DSIRE staff identified 18 states and the District of Columbia with public benefit funds for energy efficiency. The amount collected by each fund varies widely from \$1.5 million annually for Delaware to more than \$200 million annually for California to spend on energy efficiency alone. Some states, such as Massachusetts and Rhode Island, leave the fund in the hands of the utilities to administer. Other state governments retain the administration of the funds for themselves like Illinois, Maine, Michigan and New Jersey. Still other states have created third-party nonprofits to administer the fund, notably Energy Trust of Oregon and Efficiency Vermont.

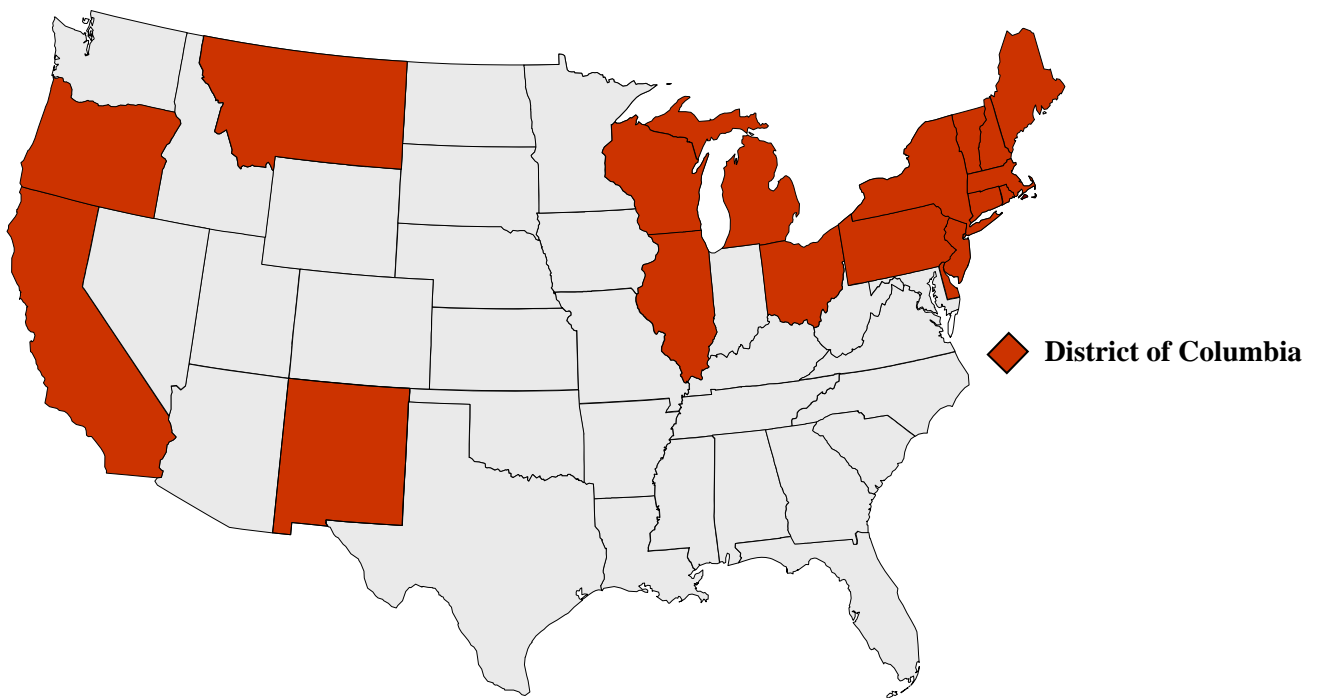


Figure 8: Public Benefits Funds for Energy Efficiency

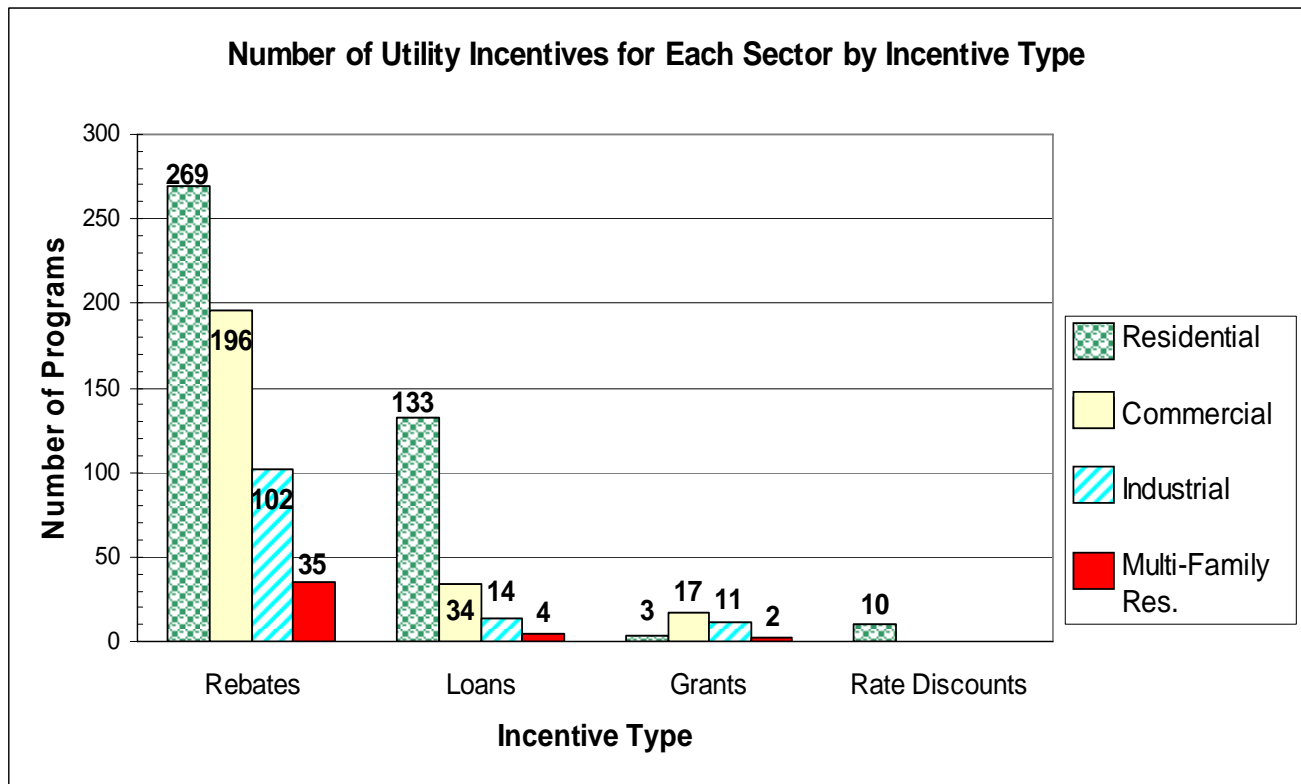


Figure 9: Utility Incentives for Energy Efficiency across All Sectors

DSIRE staff researched financial incentives for energy efficiency offered by investor-owned, municipal and cooperative utilities nationwide. Every investor-owned utility was examined in this process, as well as all municipal utilities and electric cooperatives with more than 30,000 consumers⁵. The effort resulted in database entries for 459 rebate programs, 30 grant programs, 156 loan programs and 10 rate discount programs, all of which promote the use of energy-efficient technologies and/or building design practices. Figure 9 displays the total number of incentives offered to each of the four sectors: residential, commercial, industrial, and multi-family residential. It is important to note that many of the incentives examined apply to two or more sectors. So, counting the numbers in the graph below will result in program totals different than those referenced above.

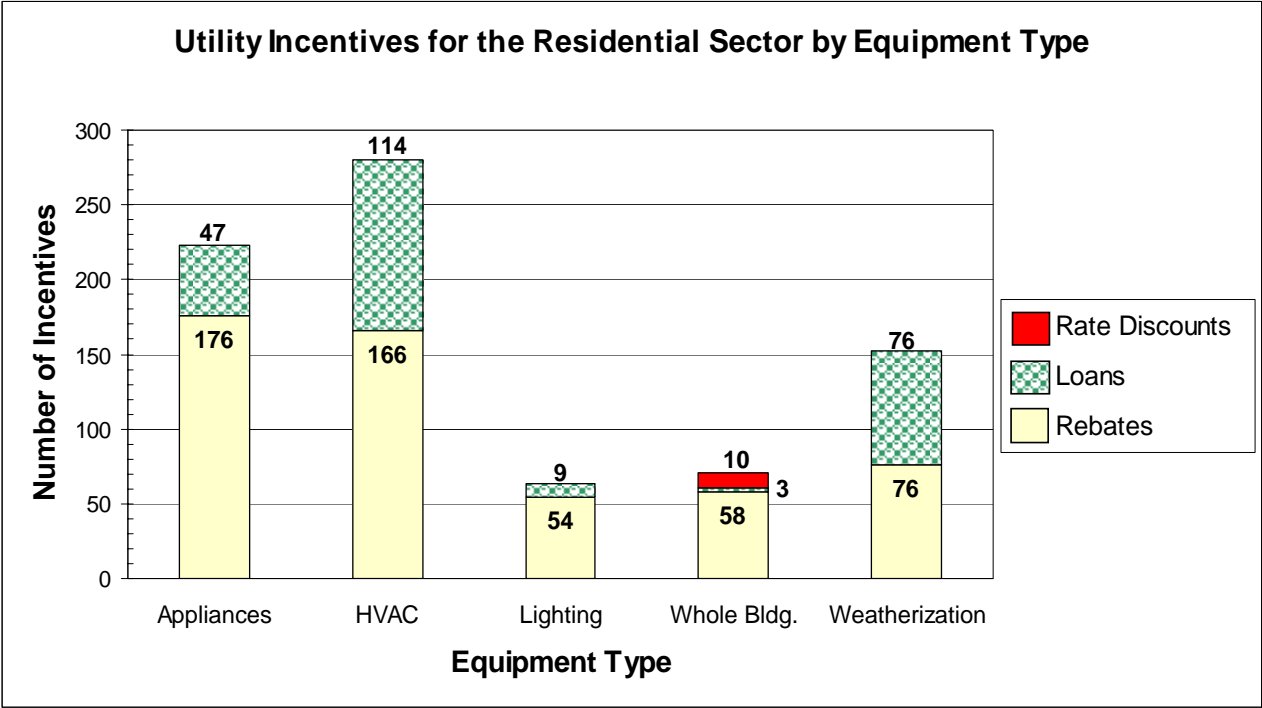


Figure 10: Residential Utility Incentives for Energy Efficiency

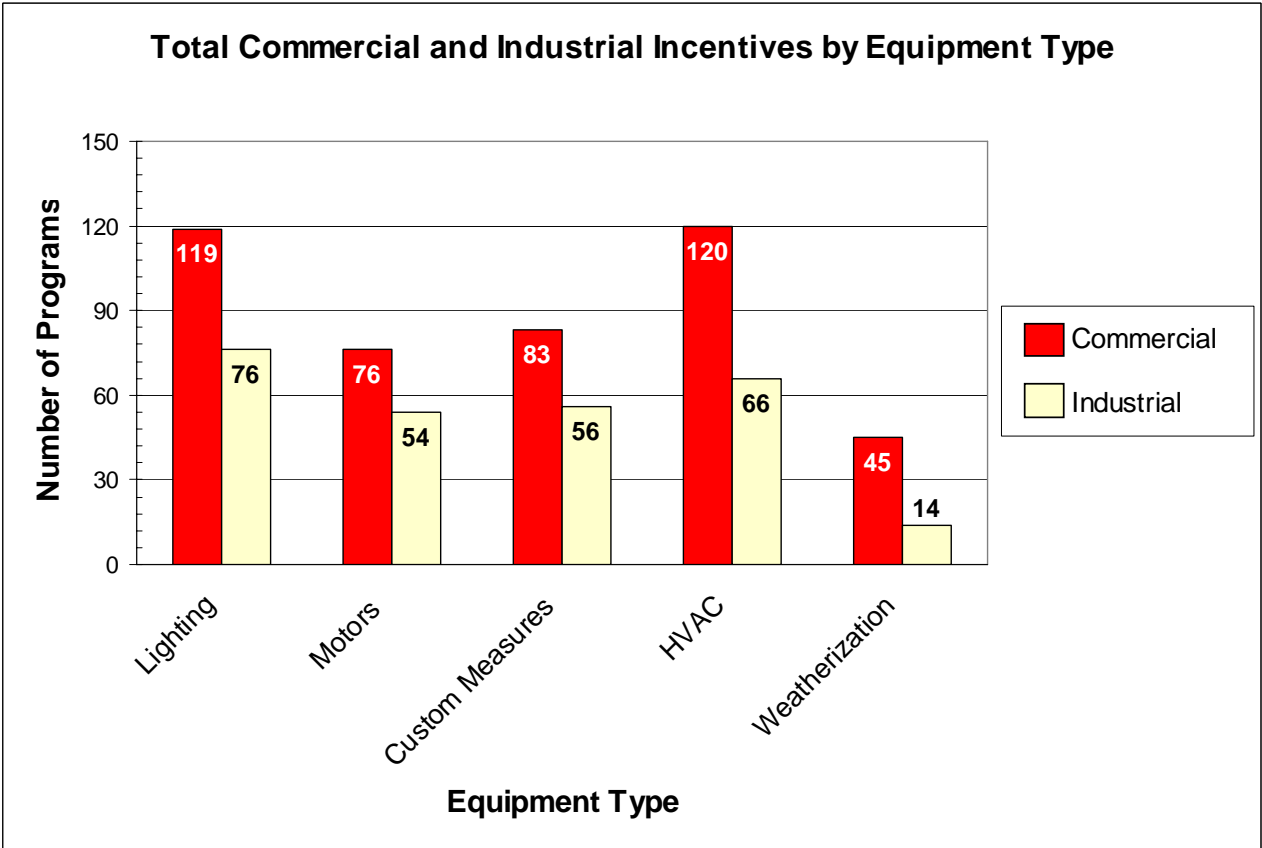


Figure 11: Commercial and Industrial Utility Incentives for Energy Efficiency

As evidenced by Figure 9, utilities nation-wide offer the most incentives to the residential sector. The commercial sector has the second highest number of incentives, followed by the industrial sector, and multi-family residential with just a handful of incentives. Figure 10 below reveals the number of incentives offered to the residential sector for each type of equipment, and Figure 11 shows the number of incentives for the commercial and industrial sectors. It is again worth noting that many utilities provide rebates or loans to two or more equipment types within one single program. As a result, the numbers will once again appear inaccurate if counted across this graph. Instead, Figures 10 and 11 simply capture the number of incentives, not programs, for each equipment type. Since there are relatively few loans and grants offered to the commercial and industrial sectors, all incentive types were combined in Figure 11.

Rebates and Grants

As indicated by Figure 10, of the 269 documented residential rebate programs, appliances and HVAC equipment are included in the majority. Similar to state rebate programs, utility rebate programs for residential customers are typically prescriptive in nature, with set rebate amounts awarded to a pre-established suite of energy-efficient equipment. Rebate amounts can range from a few dollars for compact fluorescent light bulbs, or \$25 to \$100 for appliances such as washing machines, dishwashers and refrigerators.

Prescriptive rebates can also have a variable dollar amount, increasing in value with increasing efficiency levels and/or equipment size. Variable rebate amounts in the residential sector are most common for HVAC equipment and weatherization materials. Insulation rebates, for example, are usually a function of either square footage installed, or the extent to which the R-value of the insulation is improved. HVAC rebates, likewise, can vary by either the efficiency level or the size of the unit. Many utilities also offer rebates for homes which meet an overall efficiency rating, usually based on the Home Energy Rating System (HERS) or Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification. These whole-house rebates can range from a few hundred to a few thousand dollars per house.

Utility rebates for commercial and industrial customers are sometimes prescriptive for equipment such as lighting, HVAC equipment and motors, but are also provided for custom measures specific to a given facility or business. These rebates may pay for a percentage of the project costs up to a certain maximum amount, or they may be a per-kW amount, based on the amount of energy saved. Due to the potential complexity and scale of energy usage in commercial and industrial facilities, utilities often require energy audits to be performed before efficiency improvements and related rebates can be explored. The cost of these audits is often included, at least partially, in the incentive package.

Some utilities offer grants to encourage energy efficiency. Of the 31 grant programs identified nationwide, 17 are available to commercial customers, 11 for industrial customers and 8 are available to low-income residences. All of the grant programs for low-income residences target weatherization measures, and some can even be used to replace old appliances such as refrigerators and water heaters. Most of the business grant programs provide a set amount of money to businesses to increase their facility's energy efficiency any way they see fit. A couple grant programs, however, can be used to fund R&D. Riverside Public Utilities in California, for one, offers an Energy Efficiency Technology Grant Program which provides grants up to \$100,000 to businesses to fund research, development and effective use of innovative energy technologies unique to a specific manufacturing techniques or process.

Low-Interest Loans

Utility loan programs for energy efficiency are typically provided for equipment or measures with large upfront costs which impose a barrier to their adoption. Loan programs are more prevalent in the residential sector, with 133 such programs identified by DSIRE staff, as opposed to 34 loan programs for commercial customers and 14 for industrial customers. Residential loans can start at \$500, but they are most commonly found between \$5,000 and \$10,000, with typical terms ranging between 12 and 60 months. Of the 133 identified loan programs for residential customers, 114 can be applied to the purchase of high-efficiency HVAC equipment and 76 can be used to increase a home's weatherization. To fund the loans, many utilities have teamed with local banks which provide the financing.

Rate Discounts

Rate discounts are a tool some utilities use to encourage energy efficiency. With only 10 such programs identified nationwide, they are rare, and apply solely to the residential sector. Each program is structured differently but for the most part, they are contingent upon the whole house receiving a favorable efficiency rating. Customers who meet the requirements of these programs can receive a certain percentage discount off their electric bills ranging between 3% and 10%. Customers of Progress Energy Carolinas, for example, can receive a 5% discount on their monthly electric bills if their home meets the standards of the ENERGY STAR home program and is rated by a registered third party.

The federal government has enacted several incentives, policies and programs to encourage energy efficiency on a national level. Financial incentives, in the form of loans, grants and tax benefits are available to numerous groups, including the building industry, the manufacturing industry, the agricultural industry, residents, and veterans. Many of these incentives were enacted as part of The Energy Policy Act of 2005 (EPAct).

First, in an effort to increase the production of energy-efficient home appliances, EPAct established tax credits for manufacturers of high-efficiency residential clothes washers, refrigerators, and dishwashers produced in calendar years 2006 and 2007. ENERGY STAR is used as the qualifying standard for these appliances and the tax credit is a per-unit amount based on production increases, and it is capped at \$75 million per manufacturer. To encourage the adoption of energy-efficient equipment in homes, EPAct also extends a tax credit to homeowners who increase the energy efficiency of their homes through either weatherization measures or the purchase of energy-efficient HVAC equipment. The tax credit for building envelope improvements is worth 10% of the cost, and the credit for HVAC equipment is a set amount based on the equipment type. The total tax credit a homeowner can claim during the two year span of this credit is \$500. Additionally, individuals taking advantage of utility incentives for energy efficiency, as described earlier in this report, do not have to include the value of the rebate or grant as part of their gross income for tax purposes, as outlined in Section 136 of the IRS Code.

EPAct also established tax incentives for commercial buildings and new homes which meet a certain level of efficiency as a whole system. The tax deduction for commercial buildings allows owners of new or existing buildings to claim a deduction of \$1.80 per square foot if they make improvements to their building's envelope, lighting or HVAC system which result in energy savings of 50% or more in comparison to a building which meets the minimum requirements of ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2001. Smaller deductions are also available to buildings which reduce their energy consumption to a percentage less than 50% of the ASHRAE Standard. The tax credit for energy-efficient new homes is available to builders, not owners of qualifying new homes. A builder can earn a credit worth \$2,000 per house which is certified to reduce energy consumption by 50% relative to the International Energy Conservation Code standard and meets minimum efficiency standards established by the Department of Energy. Manufactured homes can qualify the builder for a \$1,000 credit if they conform to Federal Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards and reduce energy consumption by 30% relative to the International Energy Conservation Code standard.

Section 9006 of the 2002 Farm Bill required the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) to create a program to make direct loans, loan guarantees, and grants to agricultural producers and rural small businesses to purchase renewable energy systems and make energy efficiency improvements. As a result, grants of 25% of the project cost are available for energy efficiency improvements, capped at \$250,000 per project. The loan guarantees are available for loans worth 50% of the total project cost, and the maximum percentage of guarantee ranges from 70% to 85% depending on the loan value. Past years have seen close to \$2 million in grants awarded for energy efficiency projects annually. The 2006 Notice of Funds Availability guaranteed \$11.385 million in funding for competitive grants and \$176.5 million in authority for guarantee loans for renewable energy systems and energy efficiency combined.

FEDERAL REGULATORY POLICIES FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY

The federal government has adopted considerably fewer regulatory policies for energy efficiency than most states, and only after the states led the way. Currently, DSIRE only maintains records for three federal regulatory policies for energy efficiency: appliance and equipment standards, energy goals and standards for federal buildings, and energy reduction goals for federal agencies.

California was the first to initiate appliance efficiency standards, which went into effect in 1974. The federal government later adopted appliance efficiency targets, with the Energy Policy and Conservation Act of 1975 (EPCA) establishing a federal energy conservation program for major household appliances. But the first mandatory federal standards were not established until the passage of the National Appliance Energy Conservation Act of 1987 which set minimum efficiency standards for 12 household appliances. In 1992, the Energy Policy Act (EPAcT) expanded the coverage of EPCA to establish maximum water flow rate requirements for certain plumbing products. EPAcT also provided for voluntary testing and consumer information programs for office equipment, luminaries, and windows. Federal appliance standards were most recently updated and expanded by EPAcT 2005, and 16 residential products and 11 pieces of commercial equipment now have uniform minimum efficiency standards.

EPAcT 2005 also reestablished and extended several earlier goals and standards to reduce energy consumption in existing and new federal buildings by 2% annually through Fiscal Year 2015. Earlier goals used FY 1985 as the baseline for energy consumption, but EPAcT 2005 designated 2003 as the new baseline. Other energy efficiency requirements introduced by this act include a requirement for federal agencies to purchase ENERGY STAR equipment when the product is cost-effective and meets the needs of the agency. Supplementing these goals was Executive Order 13423: Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management, which was signed by the President on January 24, 2007. It established total energy reduction goals for every federal agency, which includes the electricity consumed by their buildings as well as the fuel consumed by their fleets. The executive order also established water reduction goals, mandated recycling programs within facilities, and made a requirement for agencies to purchase electronic equipment which is registered with the Electronic Product Environmental Assessment Tool.
